## **92000-2011 GM Billet Two-Piece Door Handle Kit Installation Instructions**

Thank you for purchasing Ringbrothers direct replacement door handles.

Installation:

Remove interior door panel.

With the window up remove the two ¼-20 bolts that are securing the original handle.

\*\*\*Save these two bolts as you may need them to secure the new handles\*\*\*

Remove the stock door handles

To install new gaskets peel off protective tape and apply the gaskets to the door handle – be sure to align mounting holes.

\*\*\*Note: there are two right hand gaskets and two left hand gaskets\*\*\*

At this time you may trim the gasket to better fit the new door handles.

Also check the door skin near the mount holes for uneven spots so the handle will sit flush on the door

Compare the length of the push to your original handles. It may be necessary to shorten the push rod. It is our recommendation to test the handles prior to shortening the push rod.

Install new handle on door by using the included ¼-20x3/4" set screw and K-lock nut on the small end of the handle. Do not use your original bolt for this end of the handle as it could damage the handle if it is too long.

We have included additional ¼-20x3/4" set screw and K-lock nut for the push button end of the handle as well. You may use your stock hardware, but be sure to check the length of your original bolt. If it is too long it will damage the handle if you attempt to over tighten it. Do not over tighten.

Test the door handle before reinstalling the door panel.

It may be necessary to re-drill the mounting handles on some GM models. This handle is a direct replacement for the 1967-69 Camaro and Firebird. Although we believe it will work on most GM models with the same style door handle.

### Who is covered by this warranty?

### What does this warranty cover?

### How long is the warranty coverage?

The warranty coverage remains in force for a period of twelve (12) months from the date that the original Consumer Purchaser buys the parts. Warranty coverage will automatically terminate if the original Purchaser sells or otherwise transfers all or any portion of the purchased parts.

### What is not covered by this warranty?

Ringbrothers shall not pay or be responsible for the cost of shipping the defective parts for service under this warranty, nor will Ringbrothers pay for the cost of labor to remove and/or replace the defective parts.

Moreover, Ringbrothers shall have no obligation under this warranty in the event that the parts become defective in whole or in part as a result of improper assembly, installation, maintenance, or use, or any other misuse or mistreatment of the part.

Ringbrothers shall have no obligation under this warranty for defects in parts with an anodized finish, when the option is selected, if the defects are caused by, but not limited to, negligence of other than Ringbrothers; an accident; ordinary wear and tear; assembly or disassembly; washing, natural occurrences like stone chips; bead blasting; improper maintenance including the use of any harsh cleaning agent, chemical or solvent; and salt or other substances used on streets and highways for maintenance and safety.

It is the responsibility of the original Consumer Purchaser to cease operation as soon as a defect or malfunction is identified or suspected.
